## ELEVATED EXPERIENCE

The **CMM Young Artist Development Program** was created and designed for the young musician who is interested in receiving a performing arts high school level of experience where we take a deep dive into modern pop and classical performance artistry.

Divided into SIX 3-hour sessions plus a showcase, students will write and produce their own song, be coached by leading professionals in the field, prepare a small ensemble work and learn important western music theory concepts necessary for writing music. Participants will also perform in a final showcase, where each person will perform a solo on a beautiful concert stage as well as ensemble piece and have their original song premiered.

### 2. Requirements

- RCM Piano level 2+ or Singing for 2+ years. Groups divided by age
- Enrolled in 45 minute private lessons
- Commitment to attend ALL dates

### 3. Cost

Tuition cost for the CMM Young Artist Development Program is \$500. Amount can be paid in full OR invoiced monthly from Oct through Mar for an additional \$85. Tuition is non-refundable and must be paid in full even if given notice of withdrawal. Space is limited!
